What is OHSAS 18001

OHSAS 18001 sets the requirements for a Health & Safety Management System at the workplace for Organizations that want to control the risks of health and safety at work and thus to improve their performance. This Standard can help an Organization implement the necessary controls and procedures in order to achieve the best possible working conditions for health and safety at work in accordance with the best internationally recognized practices. The Standard does not set specific performance criteria for risks neither gives detailed guidance for planning a management system.

Target Audience

The requirements of OHSAS 18001 Standard can be applied to any Organization that wishes:

To establish a Management System for Health and Safety at work in order to reduce or eliminate risks associated with employees and other interested parties related to its activities that may be at risk

To implement, maintain and continually improve a Health & Safety Management System

To ensure the internal compliance to the company's Policy

To communicate this compliance to external interested parties

To seek the certification for Health & Safety Management System
